Managing our M&E work across the organisation, the postholder will work closely with the Executive Director, the Funding and Communications Officer as well as mentoring staff to improve our ability to record and tell the story of our work through the journeys and outcomes of our participants. In addition, the post holder will build on existing networks and forge new ones to develop and share best practice, as well as contributing to our ability to engage both supporters and funders.

The successful candidate will be passionate about working with vulnerable young people and be skilled in developing and using tools to best monitor and evaluate our work in support of our participants. They will be a team player, a clear communicator with an inquisitive and analytical mind, maintaining the highest standards of professional boundaries and quality in all their interactions.
